This is a full-time, ten-month faculty position reporting to the Middle School Coordinator.

PRIMARY JOB RESPONSIBILITIES

- Plan and implement lessons for active student learning; use a variety of tools to assess student progress toward learning goals, making necessary instructional adjustments
- Demonstrate the ability to engage students in content with a focus on conceptual as well as procedural math knowledge
- Support the individual needs of children while managing whole group experiences
- Implement effective classroom management strategies to maintain a classroom environment conducive to learning.
- Advocate for advisees, encouraging growth toward "responsible independence"
- Collaborate with colleagues to enhance the entire middle school experience for students
- Communicate positively and proactively with parents
- Participate in professional growth opportunities
- Fulfill obligations for student supervision outside the classroom and all professional responsibilities for academic reporting
